Notes and Definitions

"Sticker Price": The sum of designated tuition, *statutory tuition*, average college/course fees, and mandatory student fees for the average undergraduate student enrolled in 15 SCH. For graduate students, the sticker price is the sum of designated tuition, graduate and professional tuition, and mandatory fees for the average graduate student enrolled in 9 SCH. Increases to Non-Resident statutory tuition released by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board in February 2012 are not incorporated into the sticker price increases.
