The University of Texas System



- 13 academic and health institutions across the state
 - 8 academic institutions and 5 health and medical institutions
- One of the nation's largest public university systems of higher education
 - Enrollment of over 243K students across the state
- UT institutions are powerful drivers of economic and social mobility in Texas
 - Produce more than 1/3 of Texas' bachelor degrees, more than 60% of medical degrees
- One of the largest employers in the state
 - Over 116K faculty, health care professionals, researchers, support staff, student workers
- Total research spending across the 13 UT institutions exceeds \$3.8 billion
 - UT System ranks No. 1 in Texas and No. 2 in the United States



General Procurement Information

- Each higher education institution has its own Contract and Procurement (CnP) teams and its own solicitation process (no central CnP)
- All University of Texas institutions have the same purchasing guidelines as mandated by the State of Texas and the Board of Regents of the University of Texas System
- A variety of solicitation methods are used and determined based on purchasing thresholds
 - Purchase orders for less than \$15K can be issued without a competitive bid, although we do recommend getting bids and including HUB vendors.
 - Informal Bids/Quotes for \$15K-\$50K require a minimum of 3 informal bids/quotes and 2 of those must be obtained from a certified Texas HUB if available.
 - For purchases over \$50K a formal bid (RFP/RFQ/RFI) is required (written formal bids/proposals) in response to a solicitation unless the good(s)/services(s) is available utilizing an approved and accredited Group Purchasing Organization (GPO).

Things you should know:

- Located in Austin, Texas, the University of Texas System Administration (UT System) is a separate entity from the UT Institutions. UT System is the administrative body of the UT institutions, and interacts daily with the institutions, providing value-added services, guidance, and support, i.e., legal counsel, government relations, strategic communications, etc.
- UT System is organized with seven executive offices, each charged with overseeing specific policies and operations while supporting the Board of Regents and the Chancellor.
 - There are over 32 departments within UT System representing all functional areas (accounting, marketing, legal, risk, audit, facilities, contracts, and procurement, etc.) that the CnP team supports
- Master Service Agreements are in place that can be utilized by all institutions for services such as Auditing, Marketing, Fundraising, Executive Search Services, and IT Staffing.
- The UT Supply Chain Alliance is the Group Purchasing Organization (GPO) of The University of Texas System.





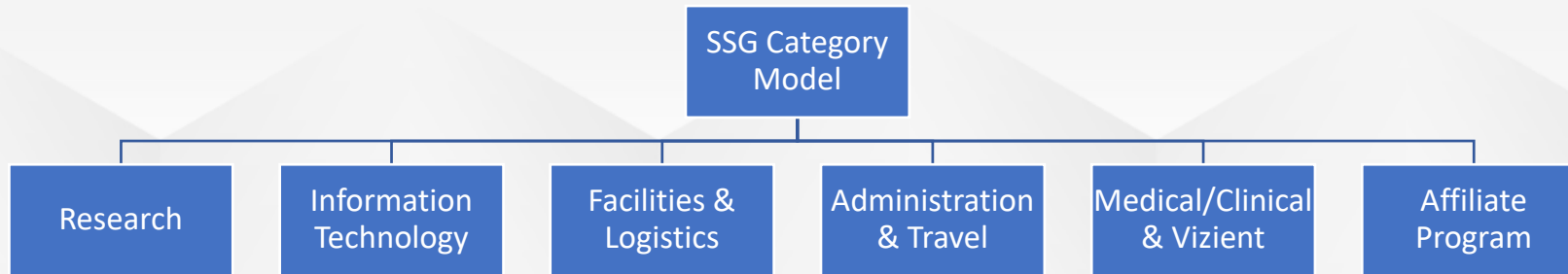
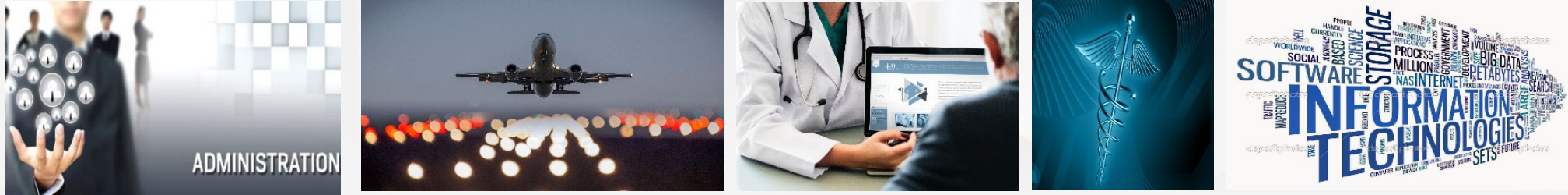

Supply Chain Alliance Overview

- The University of Texas System Supply Chain Alliance referred to as “Alliance” or “UTSSCA”
- **Established by UT System in 2007** as an internal GPO (Group Purchasing Organization)
- Focused on Academic Health and Higher Education Institutions
 - **13 UT Members** (5 Health, 8 Academic)
 - **53 Affiliates** (including several multi-campus university systems)
- Leverages the collective size and strength of UT Members and Affiliates to facilitate group purchases that yield better pricing and service levels than any institution could achieve on its own.
 - **Combined market spend >\$2B in products and services**
 - Alliance contract portfolio consists of over **60 strategic supplier agreements**
 - Alliance contracts create potential aggregate savings opportunities
- **Use of Historically Underutilized Businesses**
 - **>69% of Alliance contract spend**
- Alliance’s Strategic Services Group (SSG)
 - Team performing sourcing and contracting, supplier relation, and customer relation services
